Greentree Park is located in the heart of Willistown Township, less than 1 mile from Route 30, between the popular and affluent Main Line towns of Paoli and Malvern. The park is host to many summer events. Plans to connect Greentree Park and Malvern Borough through Randolph Woods would make the park more accessible to a greater population of residents.

The East King Street Project will produce 190 additional living units across the street from Randolph Woods and within walking distance to Greentree Park.

Greentree has swings, a small play system, and a few other small pieces of equipment. There is a paved path (perfect for tricycles and scooters), a picnic area in the gazebo, a basketball court, and lots of open green space. And Greentree has restrooms! What Greentree doesn't have is sufficient equipment for toddlers and older kids. With the addition of just a few more pieces of equipment, Greentree Park would be enjoyed by a much greater portion of our community.”*

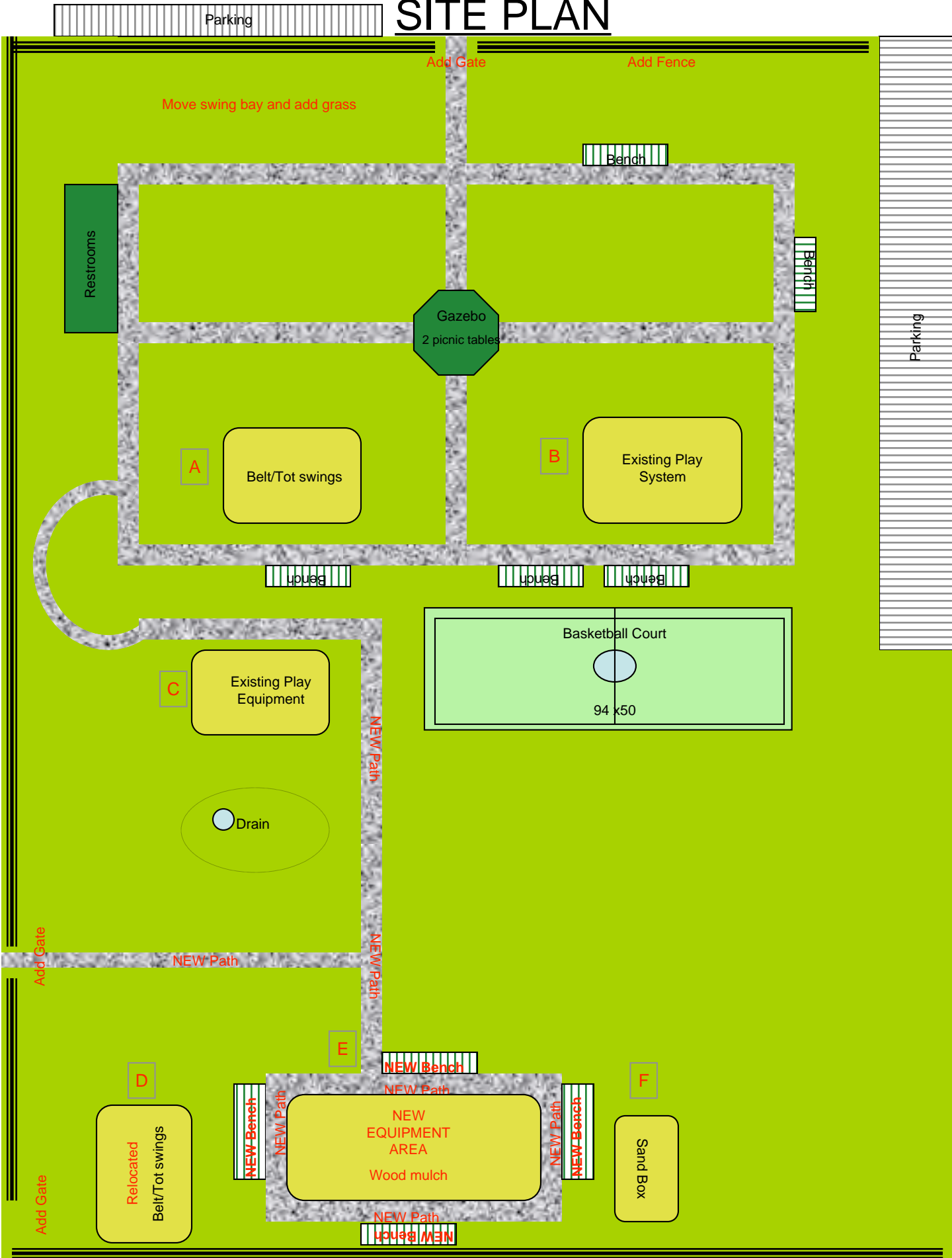

# EQUIPMENT PLACEMENT

We chose the southwest corner of the park for section **D**, **E**, & **F** because:

1. The wood line will provide shade so that both children and equipment stay more cool.
2. Having all new equipment in one area will allow families with multiple children to better utilize the park more safely.
3. The wide-open, green view of the park will not be disrupted by lots of playground equipment.
4. By making one new, large equipment area across the field we hope to encourage families to use the green space.
5. The Woodland Ave side of the park can be better utilized for events with more grass and fewer distractions.

## Considerations in addition to equipment that need to be discussed include:

1. A sand box needs to be added. This can be a community project and the Dads of the Moms Club of Malvern would be happy to support it. Parks to research that have sand are East Goshen and Friendship. This will allow kids to bring sand toys to the park to play. It's inexpensive and easy to maintain.
2. Pavement to extend the path to the new entrance on Grubb Road and the new play area would be needed.
3. 2 new pieces of equipment are around \$1,000 and could potentially be sponsored by a local business or group of local businesses. There are several in the building across the parking lot from the park to contact. It's a tax write-off!
4. Wire, screen or a protective barrier on the storm drain is necessary. Rolling balls and children's heads fit inside the drain hole. It's an accident waiting to happen.
5. An entrance gate on Grubb Road is necessary. Currently residents living on Grubb and Third Ave have to walk and push strollers on busy Grubb Road up to Woodland in order to enter the park. However, an open entrance may be a problem as small children will try to exit through any opening. A gate is necessary in the southwest corner and at the new entrance on Grubb Road.
6. Additional fence and a gate is needed along the Woodland Ave entrance to ensure that small children do not wander onto the road during events or playtime at the park.
7. A sidewalk on Grubb Road outside the park fence would be helpful, again, so those venturing to the park on foot can get to the entrance safely.
8. There is still plenty of open green space, even with these equipment suggestions. The addition of a couple soccer goals might encourage residents to use this open space more often.
9. We're hoping both Willistown and Malvern Borough have an interest in improving the play facilities at Greentree if their plans to connect the borough to the township through Randolph Woods are still in the works.

### **Consider for the future:**

1. See saw
2. 16' Independent Tire Swing
3. A large picnic pavilion that could be rented out for parties, similar to East Goshen or Valley Stream.
4. A small spray park area (using existing plumbing). An example is Bell Tavern Park in Downingtown.
